Your first step in participating in the UMBC in Morocco Summer 2015 Study Abroad Program is submitting an application. Please read the application instructions carefully. As part of the application procedure, we require you to:

- ❑ Submit the attached completed UMBC in Morocco Summer 2015 application form.
- ❑ Provide a copy of the biographical information page of your passport. If you do not already have a passport, apply now. Make sure your current passport will be valid for at least 6 months after the end date of the program. If you are traveling on a passport other than US issued, please make sure you do not need a visa or other documentation to travel out of the country/enter Morocco.
- ❑ Meet with Dr. Samir El Omari for an interview.
- ❑ Pay a \$50 application fee charges to your myUMBC account upon submission of your application.
